## NNEC RULES AND ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. The contest is open to any student who is a high school junior during the academic year 2018-2019.
2. NNEC must serve the student's primary residence with electricity.
3. A student's application, letter of recommendation, and essay must be received at Northern Neck Electric Cooperative by no later than 5pm on Friday, February 1, 2019.
4. The selection of finalists will be based on a student's application, letter of recommendation, and essay. The finalists will be contacted for an in-person interview. After all finalists have been interviewed, NNEC will select up to four winners.
5. Winners must be able to attend the 2019 Washington Youth Tour if selected, as this is an all-expense paid trip to Washington, D.C.
6. Once submitted, a student's completed application becomes the exclusive property of Northern Neck Electric Cooperative.
