RULES AND ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. NNEC must serve the applicants' primary residence with electricity. The contest is open to high school juniors in Lancaster, Northumberland, Westmoreland, Richmond, and King George Counties, as well as Stafford High School.

2. Northern Neck Electric Cooperative sponsors this contest. The selection of finalists is based on the application, recommendation, and essay. The finalists will be contacted for an interview in late February and winners will be announced March 1, 2018.

3. Winners will attend the Washington Youth Tour. This is an all expense paid trip to Washington, D.C., from June 10-14, 2018. The winner must be able to participate in the Washington Youth Tour. This is the purpose of the contest.

4. Deadline for submitting student application, recommendation and essay is February 16, 2018.
